

## 2009 Rule Book Changes

### Page 5 all divisions

We welcome all drivers, owners and crewmembers to race at Rocky Mountain Raceways. All drivers must be 16 years of age or entered into hornet driver development program (ages 14-15) to participate in events at RMR

### Page 6 all divisions

All persons entering the pit area must buy a pit pass and sign the insurance release form. All persons must be (a) a minimum of 18 years of age to enter the pit area (b) a minimum of 16 years of age with a signed parental/guardian consent form (c) 14 or 15 years old and registered in hornet driver development program and accompanied by parent.

Page 32 Super Stocks

Page 45 Modifieds

a: **Fuel must be unaltered track gasoline.** No nitrous oxide, or oxygenated fuels or additives. No performance-enhancing fuel additives of any kind.

1. Blending with unaltered street fuel will be allowed up to 50/50 mix.

Page 53 Hornets

a.: All cars must be 4cylinder, front wheel drive. All cars must remain completely **STOCK** bumper to bumper. Minimum wheelbase is 93 inches.

Page 48 Modifieds

A: Manual Transmissions

1. OEM manual gear type transmissions must have a standard OEM case and must have a working clutch inside an SFI approved explosion proof steel bell housing.
2. Aftermarket manual gear type transmissions utilizing an internal clutch inside an aluminum case will be allowed. A 153 tooth unaltered OEM or OEM replacement flex plate inside an SFI approved explosion proof steel bell housing must be used. A 2 ¾ lb steel transmission coupler required. Starter must be mounted in OEM location!

Page 14 Qualifying classes

INVERTED STARTS IN HEATS & A-MAIN (**one second or slower cars will start scratch**)
